Course Deposits are required to hold dates and are non-refundable/non-transferrable 30 days prior to the course start. Deposits paid are applied to your invoice at course end. 5 Days or More in Duration: \$3500; Less than 5 Days in Duration: \$1500. In certain cases, a Purchase Order can be accepted in lieu of the Course Deposit - please inquire.

Standard Instructor Expenses/Reimbursements:

*Barring emergencies that require last-minute staffing, we can provide you with a travel estimate when we commit your course to running 30 days prior to the start date, upon request.

On All Courses:

If instructors fly in, they will require shuttle from and to the airport, and reasonable shuttle access to grocery stores or other amenities as needed. If a shuttle cannot be provided, a car rental or access to a sponsor vehicle will be necessary.

Acceptable lodging options include:

- Private lodging away from students
- Single-occupancy motel rooms, private rooms in hostels, and guest apartments
- Separate, private bedrooms for faculty are required; faculty are expected to share bathroom, kitchen and living space
- Camping is acceptable on 2-3 day courses when the facility itself is limited to camping only
- Lodging with a full kitchen option is preferred on courses longer than 4 days

Instructor Expense: Flat Rate

<u>Lodging</u>, to be provided continuously from the night before the course starts through and including the night immediately following the course. Not acceptable are dormitories, floors, guest rooms, and couches.

Service Fee (optional, travel and meals fee):

- The most popular course lengths and associated fees are:
 - 2 days: \$1329.00
 - 3 days: \$1447.00
 - 5 days w/full kitchen: \$1393.00
 - 9 days w/full kitchen: \$1633.00
- Includes the potential for one airfare and one RT mileage expense, and meals for the course duration and travel days

Lodging, as stated above plus the following itemized (actual) expenses

Course Meals Per Instructor:

5 Days or More in length Course days, with a full kitchen: \$30/day Course days, with no kitchen: \$59/day Courses 1-4 Days in length Course days: \$59/day

Travel Per instructor:

- Travel Meals: \$29.50/day
- \$0.67/mile round-trip (subject to change based on current IRS rate) or \$750/airline travel cap.

Course Cost - Estimation Worksheet

Estimate your retail price per student. Refer to your contract for tuition amount per student, minimum enrollment, and additional fees if they apply. Consider advertising costs, classroom space rental, or other administrative costs you incur and enter them into line 5.

Reduce your costs by:

- providing onsite lodging and 3 healthy, square meals per day
- provide a vehicle/shuttle for our faculty to and from airports and grocery stores, etc
- we seek to have instructors carpool and manage airport shuttles, to reduce mileage whenever possible
- we price airline tickets 30 days prior to your course, at the best price break, and usually come in well under the \$750 travel cap per instructor
- capitalize on marketing opportunities to maximize your enrollment, in order to broaden your budget margins and gain free tuition spots (1st at 20 enrolled, 2nd at 29 enrolled).

Required Classroom Space:

An ideal space includes the following criteria:

- Minimum 1200 sq ft of open space, with heat/air as indicated for the weather and location. Outdoor sheltered spaces during reasonable weather/seasons.
- Mounted writing surfaces (whiteboards, etc.)
- WiFi access and projector are preferred, but not required.
- Direct access from the classroom to outside scenario spaces (fields, wooded, etc.) and aquatic spaces as required by the course type.
- Sponsor must hold appropriate permits and insurances, and is responsible for any pertaining fees, for operating any portions of Landmark coursework on public or private lands.
